However, written notice must be given to the Trial Secretary **no later than 6pm on Monday, April 26th, 2010**. Day to day move-ups will be accepted if received **before the close of the trial Saturday, May 1st, 2010**. Trial close will be considered to be the awarding of ribbons for the last class on that day. Move-ups will be added to the end of the running order of the class they move up to and every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs in the same class.

Move-up form must be submitted—Verbal requests will not be accepted. Fill out each change and send to the Trial Secretary's home address. **E-mailed requests accepted as long as all information is included.**

SITE INFORMATION:

All classes will be held in climate controlled building on stall matting. Ring size is 112ft x 72ft. Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the entire area clean. Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dogs on the trial grounds will be excused from the trial with no entry fees refunded.

CRATING:

There will be limited indoor crating available. Please be prepared to stack crates or use the elevated crating platforms indoors. X-pens and oversized chairs not allowed indoors. There is ample space outside for tents, but limited shade. Crates and tents may be left overnight,, however, TROCCW and Camp Bandy will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. Dogs may not be left overnight. **No exhibitor set up before 6:30 am.**

FOOD:

Food and beverages will be available at the show site on Saturday and Sunday. There is a Subway restaurant 5 min to the east on Cty Rd B at intersection with Cty Rd K in Amherst.

CATALOGS:

Running order sheets will be available to all exhibitors at no charge. Full catalogs will be available for sale for \$7.00 on the day of the trial, but supplies will be limited. Advanced catalog sales \$5.00. Please indicate on your entry form if you would like a catalog.

PRIZES AND AWARDS:

Ribbons will be awarded to First through Fourth place in each class and height division. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to those dogs receiving qualifying scores. New title ribbons, Double Q ribbons, MACH ribbons & bars and PAX ribbons & bars will also be awarded. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. Prizes must be claimed the day of the show—none will be mailed.

JUMP HEIGHT DIVISIONS:

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division.

26 inch jump height may be entered at the owner's discretion.

HEIGHT CARD REQUIREMENT:

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. *Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.*

REFUNDS:

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Entry fee for bitches that come into season or a dog that is injured after the closing date will be refunded (less \$12 administrative fee per day) if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial.

OBSTACLES:

Obstacles will meet the specifications in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER:

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

RINGSIDE:

Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having the dog ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and the judge by checking in with the gate steward well ahead of your turn, and being prompt at the line when your turn comes to run.

SAFETY AND BEHAVIOR:

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulation of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

LIABILITY:

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. TROCCW, and its members, agents, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

HOTEL INFORMATION:

The following area hotels accept well-behaved people and their pets. Exhibitors must contact hotels directly and identify themselves as having dogs. Some of these hotels do charge an extra fee for dogs. Be sure to verify the dog policy with the hotel of your choice when you make your reservation. From North, South and West: From I-39 in Stevens Point, take Hwy 10 East (towards Waupaca) to Lake Road/Amherst Junction Exit. Turn right onto Lake Road. Cross railroad tracks, bear left & continue on Lake Road after first stop sign (Lake Emily will be on your right). Turn left at second stop sign onto Lake Emily Rd. Camp Bandy is on the Left (approximately 5 blocks).

From East: Hwy.10 West to Amherst (approximately 10 miles from Waupaca). approximately 10 miles to the County Road B exit. Turn Right onto Cty B. Almost immediately, turn left onto County Road Q. Approx 1 mile down, road makes a 90 degree turn to the left and becomes Main Street. Stay on Main St (Q will turn to the right). Camp Bandy is on the Right just out of town (approximately 3 blocks).

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. Mixed breed dogs entered in these events must list the breed name as "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) and not as a breed hybrid and must include their AKC Canine Partners number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
